

CS1100 Computer Science and Its Applications

1. Open your Blackboard account and make sure this course, **CS1100**, is listed among your courses.
2. Go to Tools / Personal Information / Edit Personal Information. In the email address box, enter the email address where you wish to receive mail from this course. You may use any account you wish as long as you check mail from that account regularly. After you have set the email address box to the email address of your choice, click submit / click OK / click OK again, you will get an error. Ignore the error.
3. Now notify the instructor that your email has been set. The instructor will send an email to that account. You will need to receive that email in order to complete the assignment. However, you may continue on while you are waiting for the email.
4. Go to <http://www.neu.edu/osccr/academichonesty.html#Cheating> and read the document.
5. Access your space in **MyFiles.neu.edu** using Microsoft Internet Explorer. Click on the WebFolder button, to open a web folder. You may have to log in again.
6. Create a new Microsoft Word Document on your desktop, then drag it (move it) into your Web Folder. You may have to enter credentials. Open the Word Document and type in the following text.
