This system is a new email system that allows you to use voice commands. The system is already trained for your voice. In this email application you will record your voice instead of typing or dictating a message to someone else. The voice message that you record will be sent to the recipient for them to listen to. We have added some email addresses in your address book and you already have some emails in your inbox. This will allow you to test the email application and tell us if it is better than your current method of accessing email. We would like you to tell us about any problems that you faced with the system.


- 1. What are the problems the user faced with the system?

- 6. Did the user understand how to select an option from a list (email list, address list, subject list)



Overlay button highlights for main screen when user gives any of the commands on the screen






